

Primary (PK-2)

Kindergarten

The following items will be shared by the class and do not need to be labeled:

- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 2 packages of baby wipes
- 3 containers of disinfecting wipes
- 3 roll of paper towels
- 4 jumbo glue sticks
- 1 package of 8 x11 colored copy paper (any color)

The following items will be used only by your child (Please label):

1 set of headphones with a microphone labeled in a ziplock bag with your child's name (similar to ones used for a smart phone). Earbuds can be purchased at Walgreens, Target, Walmart and Amazon. If you think your child will have trouble using these you can purchase regular headphones.



Please send an extra change of clothes to be kept at school in case of an emergency. Please label your child's name on the inside of all clothing. Send a full set of underwear, pants, and shirts.

Swim classes begin the second week of school. Students will need a swimsuit, swim cap (if hair is longer than 1") and swim bag to keep their suits in (towels will be provided by NTA). Many students feel more comfortable with goggles but they are not required. Please write name on swimsuit tags and cap. Suits will be sent home after swim to be washed and returned for the next swim class. Reminders of swim days will be included in the weekly kindergarten newsletter.

*Please make sure your student has a standard size backpack (take-home folders do not fit in the mini size backpacks)!

Your child should have the following items at home for homework and other activities:

- Crayons
- Pencils (regular pencils are fine, however at this age the fat pencils are great for developing writers and is what we will be using initially in the classroom)
- Pencil sharpener
- Glue
- Scissors
